


PAY ITEM NOTES

<u>MOT</u>	Shall include all elements required per FDOT standards and include temporary centerline/stop bar delineation at all non working times, stationing/offsets, and any edge of pavement reclamation where required.
<u>Silt Fence</u>	Shall be placed at all areas of potential stormwater runoff as directed by the Engineer.
<u>Milling</u>	Average depth shall be 1.25 inch and shall be achieved with a milling machine or engineer approved equivalent. Millings shall be delivered to Columbia County Public Works Material Yard. Please see attached map.
<u>Shoulder Construction</u>	Shoulder shall be tilled and reworked between asphalt layers..
<u>Borrow</u>	Shall be placed at direction of engineer
<u>Subsoil Exc.</u>	Item includes cost to remove 2' of unsuitable material and replace with suitable fill in 6" lifts meeting density requirements
<u>Asphalt 9.5</u>	Includes placement of SP 9.5 @ +/-137.5 lb/sy. To maintain level access to driveways, an apron shall be required at all driveway locations unless other directed by engineer and will be paid for under this item.
<u>Asphalt 12.5</u>	Includes placement of SP 12.5 @ +/-165 lb/sy.
<u>Seed and Mulch</u>	Shall be placed at all disturbed areas not sodded, as directed by the engineer.
<u>Sod</u>	Includes cost to place 3.5' sod width along edge of pavement and in areas directed by the engineer.
<u>Painted Pavement Markings</u>	Shall include striping the roadway back to existing layout and shall include stop bars at all stop conditions, centerline/edgeline striping (2 coats each)
<u>Sign – Single Post</u>	Includes replacement of existing signs within project limits and placement of new signs as directed by the Engineer

The conditions of this Bond are such that if the Owner accepts the bid of the Contractor within the time specified in the bid documents, or within such time period as may be agreed to by the Owner and Contractor, and the Contractor either (1) enters into a contract with the Owner in accordance with the terms of such bid, and gives such bond or bonds as may be specified in the bidding or Contract Documents, with a surety admitted in the jurisdiction of the Project and otherwise acceptable to the Owner, for the faithful performance of such Contract and for the prompt payment of labor and material furnished in the prosecution thereof; or (2) pays to the Owner the difference, not to exceed the amount of this Bond, between the amount specified in said bid and such larger amount for which the Owner may in good faith contract with another party to perform the work covered by said bid, then this obligation shall be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect. 


